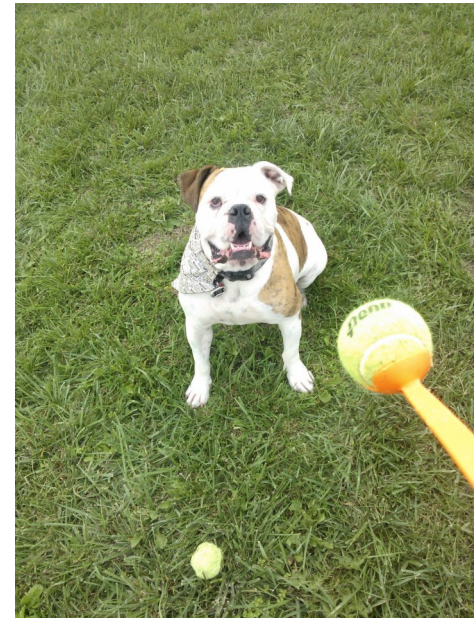
Hey Guys and Gals!
