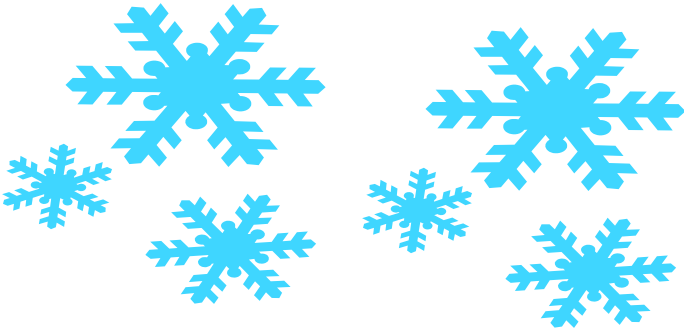
New Equipment— Periodically during the year we have requests for video logging of a borehole and until recently we would either turn down the work or have to rent a camera and digital video recorder. The last time we rented a camera the cost to the client for just the camera was over \$2,400 for 2 days of rental and shipping fees. So to better serve our clients we decided to purchase our own camera.

The camera we purchased is a Well-Vue model WV-C500FE. This camera is equipped with a 500 ft. cable, it will fit inside of a 2-inch well and has a 180 degree fish eye lens on the camera to allow you to see the sides of the well and straight down at the same time. The digital video recorder records directly to a SD card for easy transfer to a computer and e-mail to our client. The digital video command console is equipped with a 15” LCD color monitor for clear easy viewing on the job site.

So the next time you need to video log a borehole or monitoring well give Bulldog Drilling a call.

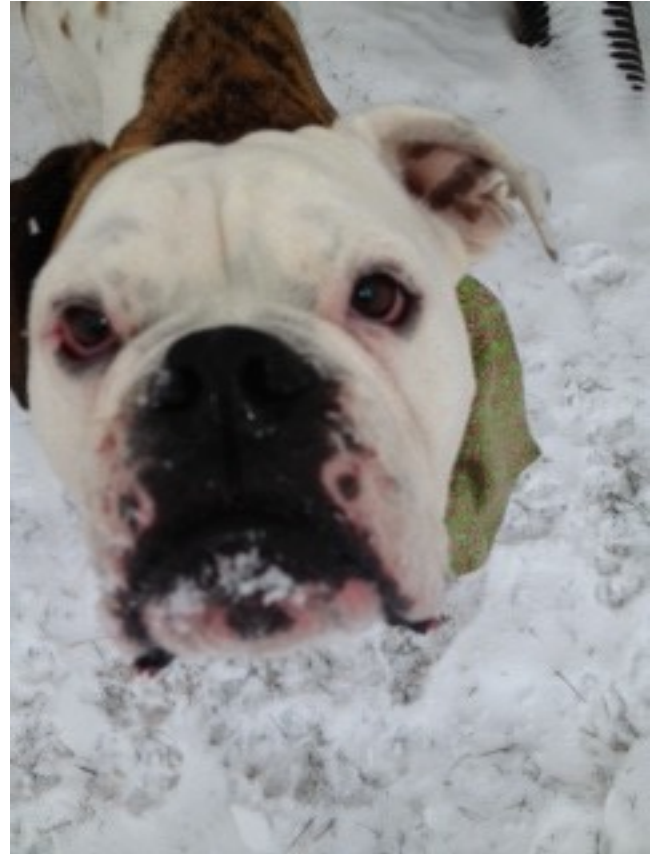
